Updates from Partners

- UNICEF
 - Proposed 800 triggerings over 5 years through DGIS Programme in Cape Mount, Gbarpolu, Grand Gedeh, Grand Kru, River Gee and Maryland
 - Held county consultative meetings in all counties during field trip (1st week of April); CLTS Guidelines should be distributed to these CSCs during next field trip
- CHF
 - Recently triggered 120 communities in Bong, Lofa and Nimba
 - Monitoring is ongoing; so far, 77 pits dug in Bong, 32 in Lofa and 107 in Nimba
 - IWASH exploring sanitation marketing in relation to CLTS
- OIC
 - Writing WASH proposal, to include CLTS
