Updates from Partners

- UNICEF
 - Supported Refresher Training of Trainers 8-10 May at MPW through the DGIS WASH Programme
 - LICH to monitor triggered towns of Kamara, Krukai and Menmeh in Montserrado County with NTCU and Montserrado County Health Team; LICH to trigger additional community at later date
 - Training of Facilitators to take place in Grand Cape Mount County during the last week of May through the DGIS WASH Programme; trainings in SE counties planned for June
 - Request for NTCU to submit names of trip participants/ trainers for Cape Mount training
- CHF
 - NTCU verified 45 ODF communities in Bong, Lofa and Nimba
 - IWASH to make presentation on marketing strategy on 22 May
